

Research Library Policies

The Tangier American Legation Institute for Moroccan Studies (TALIM) Research Library is a closed-stack library. It is temporarily located a 5-10 minute walk from the Legation during renovations to the Library building. To access the collection, please [make an appointment](#).

Library Hours:

Monday through Friday 9:00-16:00

Saturday and Sunday: Closed

- Materials in the library are non-circulating and may only be consulted there.
- The library assistant will recover books from the shelves for you. Please do not browse the shelves or remove any books yourself.
- Keep all materials on the table.
- The maximum number of books that researchers can view in one session is three (3) books.
- You must register with the library assistant prior to consulting resources. To do so, please bring a copy of one piece of official identification (student ID, passport, etc.).
- Do not write in or mark any book.
- Treat library equipment and facilities with care.
- Keep your mobile phone on silent mode.
- Do not smoke.
- Do not eat or drink in any part of the Library except the kitchen.

Failure to follow these rules will result in loss of access to the Library.
